
## It's that time of year again...

Spring is just around the corner and you and your pets are probably itching to go and spend time outdoors after a long winter. This warmer spring weather, however, brings two new challenges to both you and your pet: ticks and mosquitos. Ticks emerge as soon as the snow melts in the spring. They are notorious for carrying and transmitting Lyme disease, a serious and potentially life-threatening illness to both humans and pets. We advise owners who are planning on spending time outdoors with their pets to consider vaccinating them against Lyme disease. We also recommend using tick prevention starting April 1st to best and your pets. Heartworm is a parasite that can be transmitted to both dogs and, occasionally, cats by mosquito bites and can cause serious health complications in your pet. Heart worm prevention is given once a month for 6 months, beginning around May 15th.
