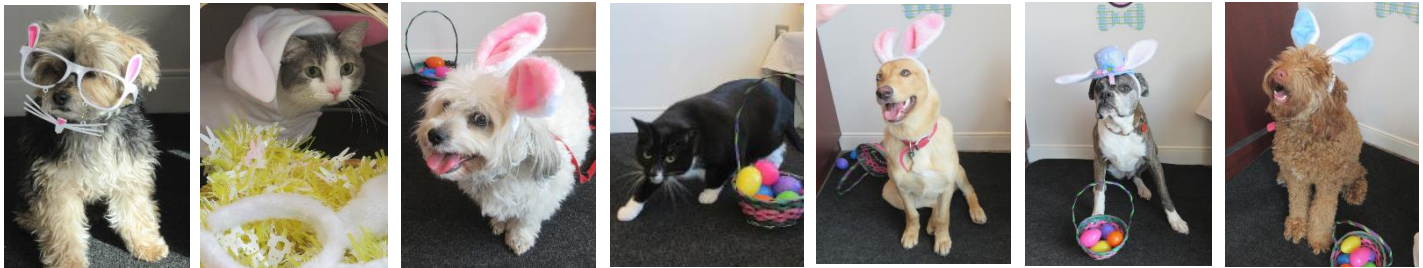


Easter Photo Booth Wind up!

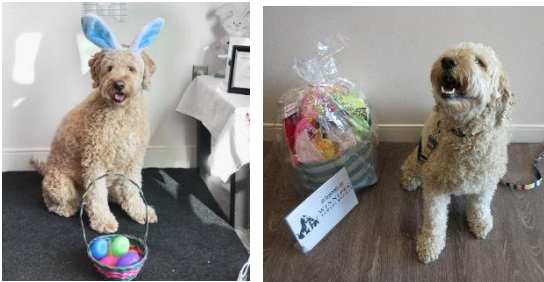

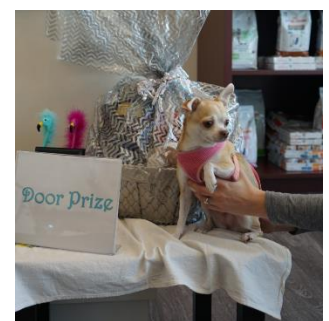
April Newsletter Prize Winners
